

Opioid Related Emergency Department (ED) Visits, Shelby County Residents- Weekly Report





Data Notes: Data is retrieved from ESSENCE-TN. 11 of the 12 Shelby County hospitals with emergency departments submit data to ESSENCE—TN.

The data represents any emergency department encounter for Shelby County residents with the term "heroin, opioid, opiate, or fentanyl" listed as a chief complaint. The data also represents any encounter with an ICD-10 code designated for heroin and opioids.

Currently all reporting hospitals in Shelby County submit ICD-10 codes.

Emergency responses to suspect drug overdose data comes from HIDTA ODMAP for Shelby County 2021.
